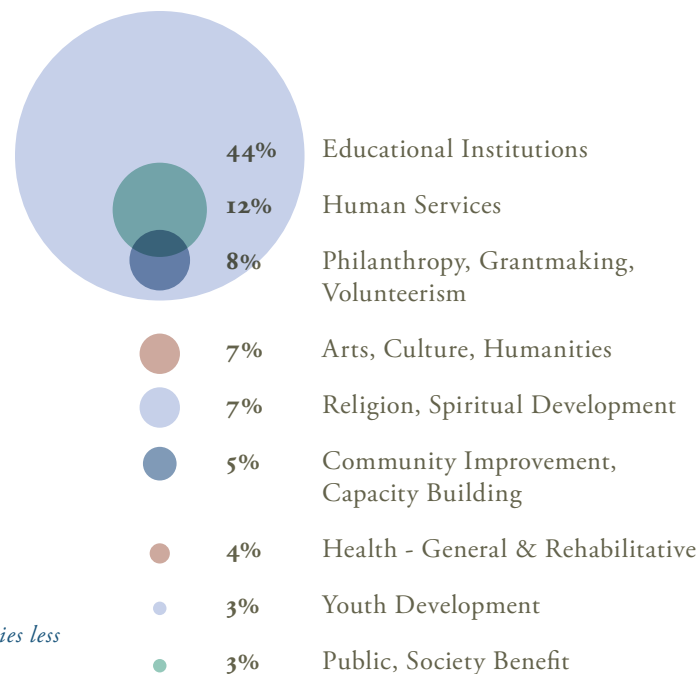

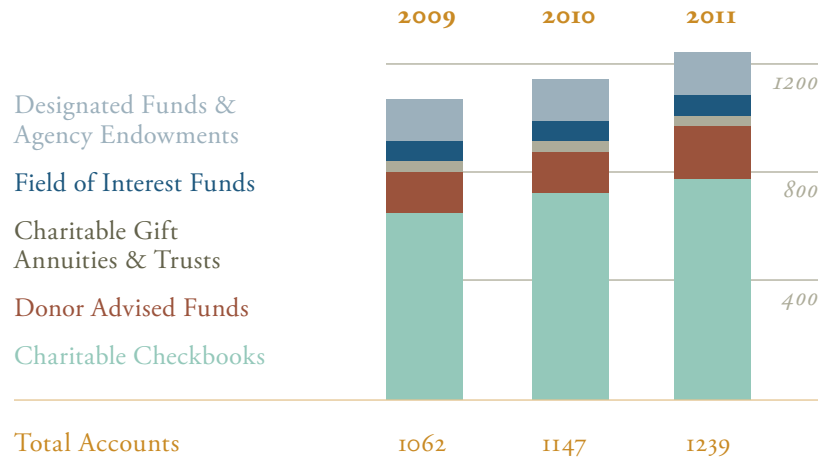

ACCOUNT GROWTH

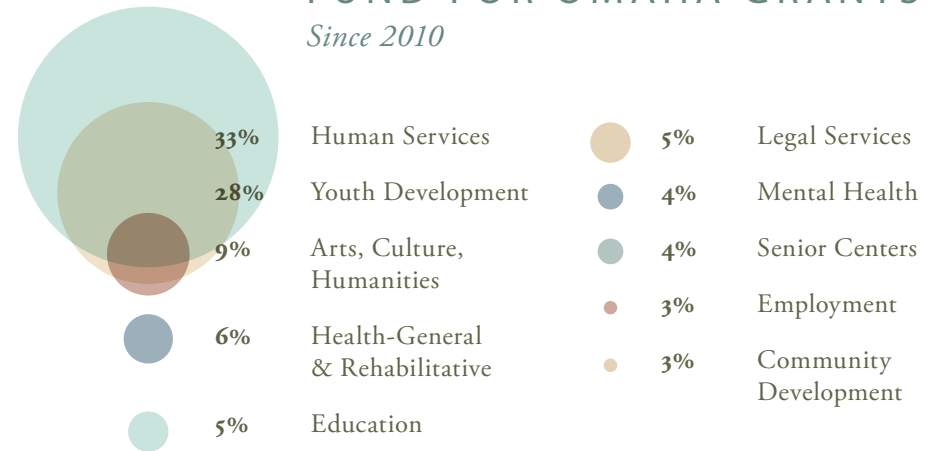

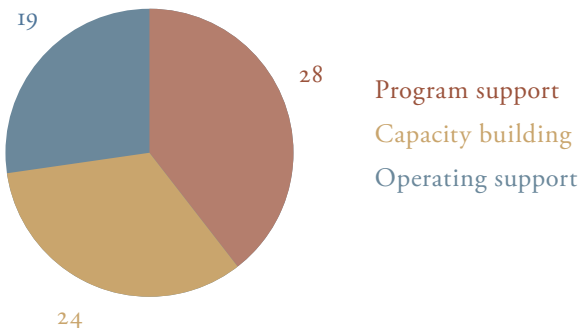
