Type of scholarships

A vocational/technical education scholarship is available for tuition at a school of the student's choice. **Four-year college programs will not be considered.**

Number of scholarships

Ten scholarships of approximately \$1,000 each.

Who may apply?

Preference shall be given to students of Missouri Valley High School, but residents of Harrison County who are high school seniors, graduates, or GED recipients who attend or have attended Missouri Valley, Logan-Magnolia, West Harrison, Woodbine, or Boyer Valley school districts may apply. Only students who are or will soon be enrolled in a two-year degreed or certified program may apply. Graduates of these programs receive certificates, diplomas, or Associate in Applied Science degrees. This scholarship is renewable, previous successful scholarship recipients may reapply for the second year.

How do I apply?

Applicants must complete a Velda R. Currie Endowed Scholarship Fund application form and submit it, along with a copy of their current transcripts and a cover letter explaining the post-high school degree or certificate they will be striving for and why the scholarship is needed, to: Harrison County Community Foundation, 1120 S. 101st Street, Suite 320, Omaha, NE 68124. Applications are available from your Guidance Counselor or online at www.swiowafoundations.org.

What is the Deadline?

Annually, scholarship materials must be postmarked no later than **March 31**st to Harrison County Community Foundation, 1120 S. 101st Street, Suite 320, Omaha, NE 68124.

Who selects the scholarship recipients?

A designated Scholarship Selection Committee appointed by the Harrison County Community Foundation Advisory Board will select the recipients.

How is the scholarship recipient notified?

High School Guidance Counselor offices are notified of selections and school traditions of public announcements are observed. A packet of materials for the recipient is provided to the High School Guidance Counselor offices. The scholarship is paid to the student's account at the educational institution the student elected.
