# Type of scholarships

A vocational/technical or a college education scholarship is available for tuition at a school of the student's choice. The graduating high school senior of a Fremont County school district must be accepted as a student by the institution of higher education.

# **Number of scholarships**

The number and amount of scholarships may vary.

# Who may apply?

Residents of Fremont County, Iowa who are graduating high school seniors may apply. Only students who are enrolled in a two- or four-year degreed or certified program may apply. Graduates of these programs receive certificates, diplomas, or Associate in Applied Science degrees.

# How do I apply?

Applicants must complete a G. Rex Gibson Endowed Memorial Scholarship application form and submit it, along with a copy of their current transcripts, to: Fremont County Community Foundation, 1120 S. 101st Street, Suite 320, Omaha, NE 68124. Applications are available from your Guidance Counselor or online at <a href="https://www.swiowafoundations.org">www.swiowafoundations.org</a>.

#### What is the Deadline?

Annually, completed scholarship materials must be postmarked no later than March 31<sup>st</sup> and mailed to the Fremont County Community Foundation, 1120 S. 101st Street, Suite 320, Omaha, NE 68124.

#### Who selects the scholarship recipients?

A designated Scholarship Selection Committee appointed by the Fremont County Community Foundation Advisory Board will select the recipients.

### How are the scholarship recipients notified?

High School Guidance Counselor offices are notified of selections and school traditions of public announcements are observed. A packet of materials for the recipient is provided to the High School Guidance Counselor offices. The scholarship is paid to the student's account at the educational institution the student elected.
