Phil and Rosie Hall Scholarship Fact Sheet Fremont County Community Foundation

Type of scholarships

A college education scholarship is available for tuition at a school of the student's choice. The high school senior from Sidney High School must be accepted as a student by the institution of higher education.

Number of scholarships

One scholarship of approximately \$1,500.

Who may apply?

Only graduating high school seniors who attend Sidney High School and are pursuing a post secondary education may apply. The criteria for a Hall Scholar give preference to a student with a keen interest and tradition of exhibiting patriotism and demonstration of enthusiasm for community service.

How do I apply?

Applicants must complete a Phil and Rosie Hall Scholarship application form and submit it to their Guidance Counselor, along with a copy of their current transcripts and an essay on "What Patriotism Means to Me". Applications are available from your Guidance Counselor or online at <u>www.swiowafoundations.org</u>.

What is the Deadline?

Annually, completed scholarship materials must be submitted to your Guidance Counselor no later than **March 31st.**

Who selects the scholarship recipients?

A designated Scholarship Selection Committee appointed by the Fremont County Community Foundation Advisory Board will select the recipients.

How is the scholarship recipient notified?

The High School Guidance Counselor office will notify the recipient of their selection and school traditions of public announcements are observed. A packet of materials for the recipient is provided to the High School Guidance Counselor office. The scholarship is paid to the student's account at the educational institution the student elected.

What are my responsibilities as a Hall Scholar?

The student must maintain a C or better grade point, or the equivalent. An official transcript must be provided to the Fremont County Community Foundation, 1120 S. 101st Street, Suite 320, Omaha, NE 68124.
