## Singleton Math and Science Endowed Scholarship Fact Sheet Mills County Community Foundation

## Type of scholarships

A college education scholarship is available for tuition at an accredited college. An East Mills High School senior applicant must be accepted as a student at the chosen college.

## **Number of scholarships**

One scholarship of approximately \$1,000 will be awarded to benefit an East Mills High School graduating senior.

## Who may apply?

East Mills High School graduating seniors may apply. The criterion gives preference to students with successful high school academic careers seeking a degree in math, science, and related fields.

## How do I apply?

Complete a Singleton Math and Science Endowed Scholarship application form and submit it, along with a copy of your current transcripts, to your Guidance Counselor. Applications are available from your Guidance Counselor or online at <a href="https://www.swiowafoundations.org">www.swiowafoundations.org</a>.

#### What is the deadline?

Completed scholarship materials must be submitted no later than **March 31**st.

What is the purpose of the Singleton Math and Science Endowed Scholarship? In making scholarship awards, the selection committee will take into consideration the student's high school academic career, with emphasis on their math and science coursework and related extra-curricular activities. Students must explain in their application how the scholarship will help them achieve their academic goals.

#### Who selects the scholarship recipients?

A designated scholarship selection committee selected by the East Mills High School will select the recipient.

#### How is the scholarship recipient notified?

Your High School Guidance Counselor office will notify the recipient of their selection and school traditions of public announcements will be observed. A packet of materials for the recipient is provided to the High School Guidance Counselor office. The scholarship is paid to the student's account at the college at which the student is enrolled.

## What are the responsibilities of a scholarship recipient?

The student must maintain a B or better grade point, or the equivalent.
